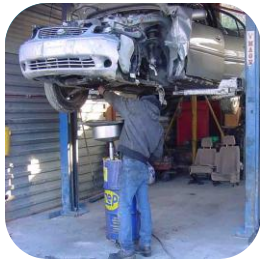

# Introduction

## *Evolution of the SCADA Partners in the Solution® Program*

The year 2012 was a groundbreaking turning point for the Partners in the Solution® program.

### Stormwater

Driven by a proposed new stormwater permit that would impose strict and costly requirements on professional auto dismantlers, SCADA committed to utilize the Partners program to deliver the highest quality information, education and training, technical assistance, and coordination of professional services and products to help members comply with their permit. This initiative will likely require significant expansion of the services offered to members, additional environmental standards, and improved stakeholder communications.

The focus in 2012 was on:

- Informing SCADA members of the proposed stormwater permit and the anticipated impacts on the dismantling industry
- Working with the State Water Resources Control Board and staff to refine the stormwater permit requirements to be reasonable and achievable for the auto dismantling industry, and to provide meaningful water quality benefits for California's waterways
- Identifying how SCADA and the Partners in the Solution® program can provide the best resources and services to help members comply with the permit
- Defining the initial steps of establishing improved communications and relationships with government regulators and environmental advocate groups

### Safety

Following an examination of the current Partners in the Solution® safety standards, SCADA decided to help members improve their safety performance and compliance with CalOSHA requirements by developing additional guidelines, training materials, and educational resources. A preliminary analysis identified several Partners safety standards that should be updated, and at least eight new safety topics that should be addressed in the new guidelines.

### Partners in the Solution® Certifications

Of the 171 SCADA members at the end of 2012, 25 members, or 15%, were not certified as being in full compliance with all of the Partners standards. About one half of those non-certified members were still working towards meeting the standards, while the other half were members who were previously certified but were "de-certified" in 2012 due to new deficiencies. It was expected that most of the de-certified members would correct their deficiencies within the first few months of 2013 and again be fully certified. SCADA has a policy that requires all members to be certified under the Partners in the Solution® program within a certain period of time. In 2012, action was taken against six members who failed to achieve certification within the designated time. SCADA also asked the local chapters to help non-certified members, instructed the Partners auditors to provide assistance, and developed additional training and information for the three standards with the most deficiencies (forklift safety training, Material Safety Data Sheets, and HazMat Reporting).

## Review of Proposed SWRCB Permit

SCADA conducted a detailed review of the permit, and analyzed the cost and impacts on the industry. SCADA submitted written comments and gave testimony at the public hearings. Staff and leaders attended numerous meetings with SWRCB.

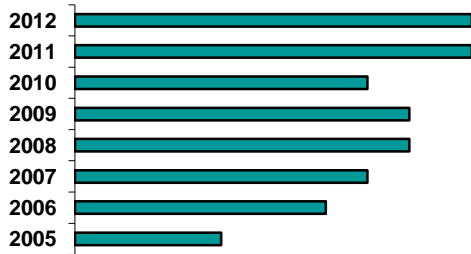

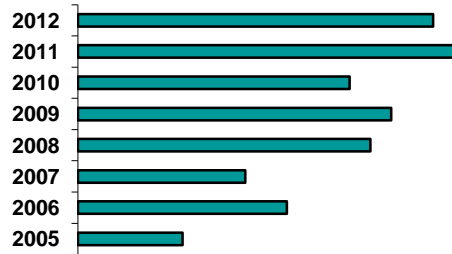

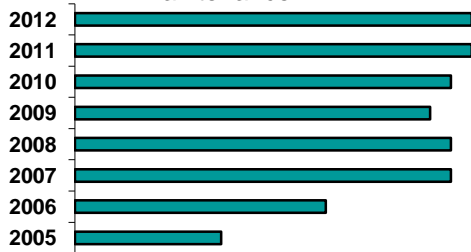
Hazardous Materials Reporting



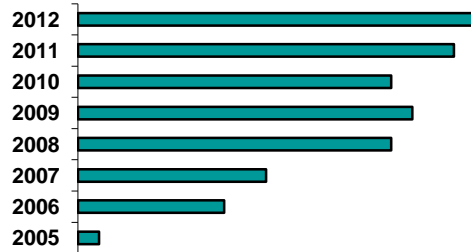
Forklift Training



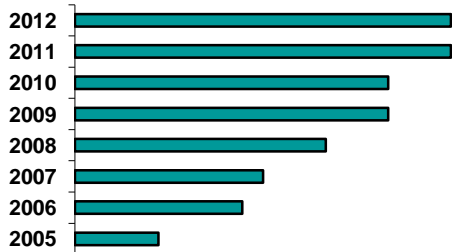

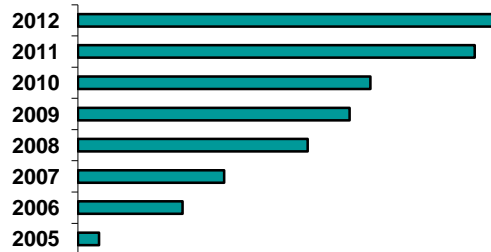

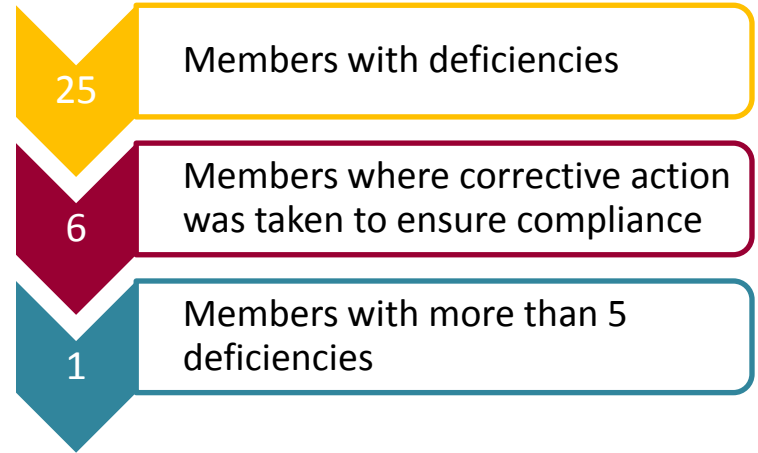

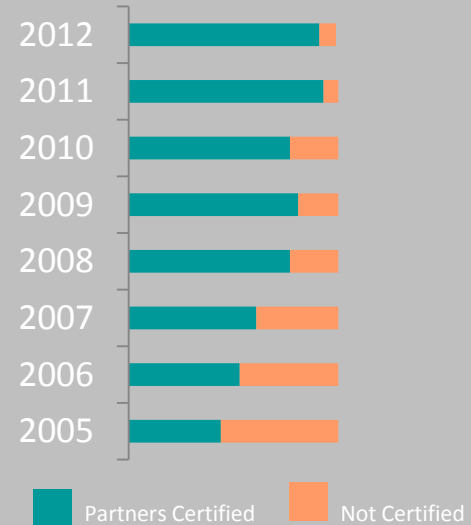
Injury & Illness Prevention Plan
